Follow River Rd. for .9 miles & take a right onto Mary Hall Rd. & follow Mary Hall Rd. for .4 miles to the stop sign. At the stop sign go straight across the intersection onto Stewart Rd. In .3 miles Steward Rd. turns into Brucker Pentway, Camp Kitchtau is about 40 ft. down Brucker Pentway on the right.
