- Collections – Bring item for 5b
- Communications (Will be a Partial)
- Dentistry – Print workbook and complete 3, 4a and 4c, 6b and 6c (for c visit dentist and bring business card)
- Disabilities Awareness (Requirements 2, 4, and 5)
- Electricity (None)
- Environmental Science (Requirement 3f)
- First Aid (Bring First Aid kit for Requirement 2d)
- Lifesaving (1ST Class and already have Swimming Merit Badge) (There will be an extra \$6.00 fee for this class to cover the facilities fee)
