Only 4% of Scouts ever earn the rank of Eagle Scout, It is an achievement that will impact their lives in ways that they have not even considered yet.

Tim Joynt and Jack Boehle have joined the 4% and earned their Eagle Rank.

In order to earn the Eagle Rank you must earn all the 13 Eagle Required Merit Badges plus an additional 8! That is 21 Merit Badges in all. Tim Has 33 Merit Badges and Jack has 36 Merit Badges. That is a lot of Merit Badge work!

Over the years in scouting Jack and Tim worked on the requirements one by one crossing off Eagle requirements as they progressed up the ranks. Each new rank completes important Eagle work! Start Early and Finish Strong.

What is the Easiest way to Eagle Scout?

1. Wait until you are 17 and work like heck.
2. Attack the needed Merit Badges and Go for it.
3. Work the Scout Program and Keep advancing.

Answer: Keep advancing, it's true, Eagle is for YOU!!
